

COVID-19 UPDATE 09/09/20 5:00 PM: Nineteen new lab-confirmed cases in Perry County, MO since 09/08 update. Twenty-two additional recoveries.

New cases 9/8: 2 lab-confirmed cases
New cases 9/9: 17 lab-confirmed cases

Active Cases: 55

We are very encouraged by the county's COVID-19 numbers over the last week and a half. The majority of today's new cases were from an isolated outbreak and will not be taken into consideration looking at overall trends in community spread. Similarly to what we have reported before, the standard for data analysis for communicable disease is to utilize the disease's incubation period when examining trends. COVID-19's incubation period is 14 days. If we continue to see decreasing trends in our analysis through the rest of the week and this weekend, the community alert level will be adjusted accordingly. We hope the spread from the recent spike in cases has been decreased by effective contact tracing and isolation of positive cases and close contacts, as well as our community heeding recommendations put out by the health department and taking personal responsibility to help do their part to decrease the spread.

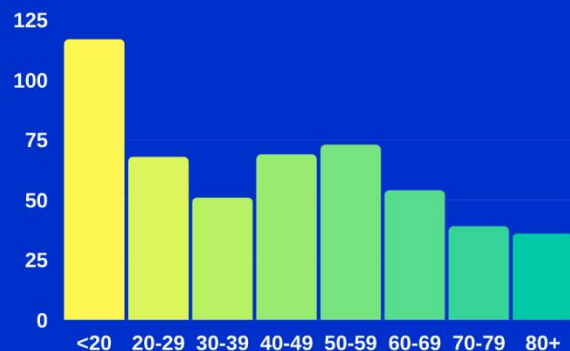

Mode of Transmission:



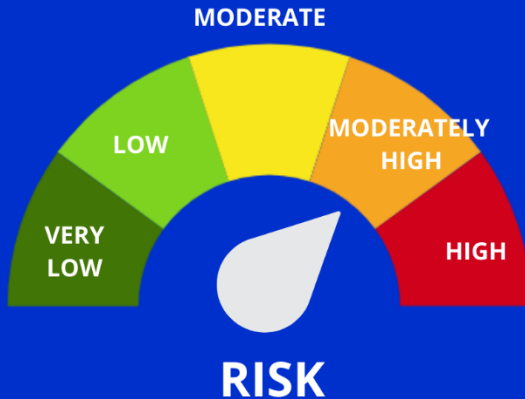


COVID-19 ALERT LEVEL

PERRY COUNTY, MO



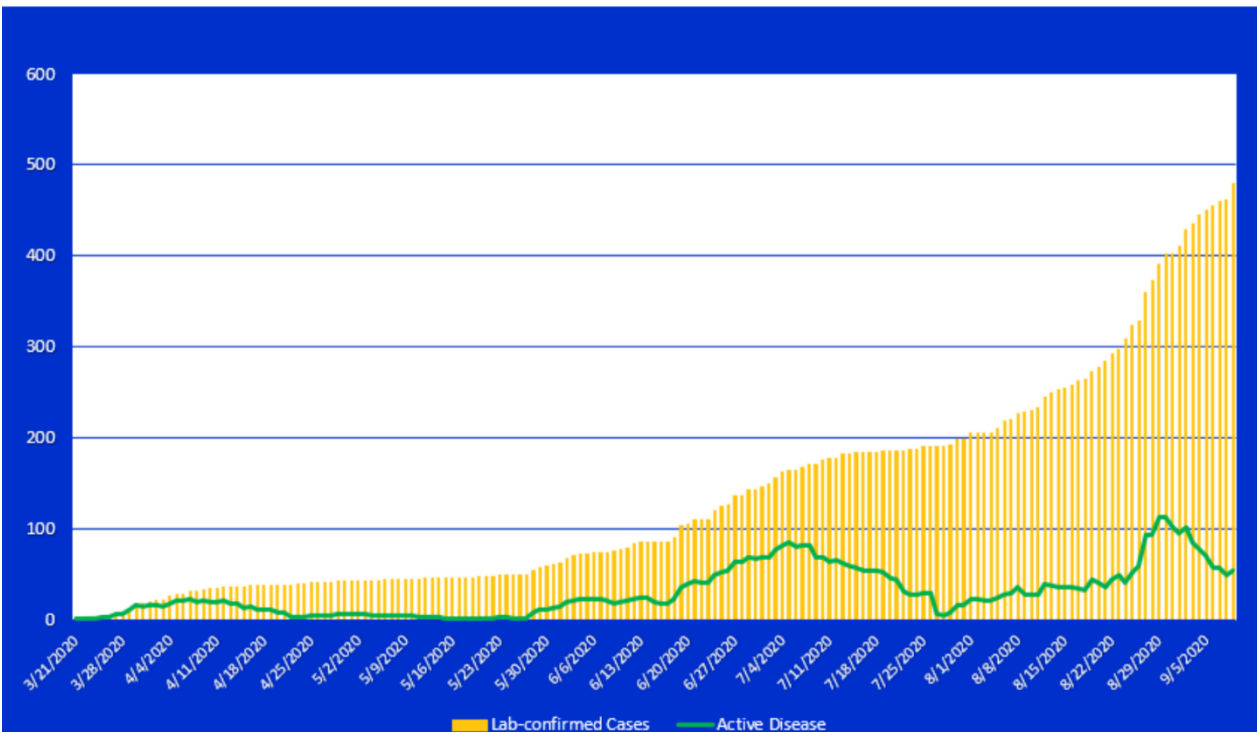
MODERATELY HIGH



ACTION STEPS:
