

COVID-19 UPDATE 09/25/20 4:45 PM: Seven new lab-confirmed cases in Perry County, MO since 09/23 update. Twenty-three additional recoveries.

We are saddened to announce an additional 3 deaths attributed to COVID in our community. Our thoughts are with these individuals' families and loved ones during this difficult time.

New cases 9/24: 4 lab-confirmed cases
New cases 9/25: 3 lab-confirmed cases

Active Cases: 55

*One of our previous probable cases has tested positive and is now considered a lab-confirmed case. Numbers have been adjusted accordingly in order to not count the individual twice in our numbers.

* One of the individuals in today's update was also counted previously. Due to the circumstances of their infection and timelines, the State of Missouri has instructed the Perry County Health Department, they will be counted a second time in our total numbers. To date, this has only occurred with one other individual.

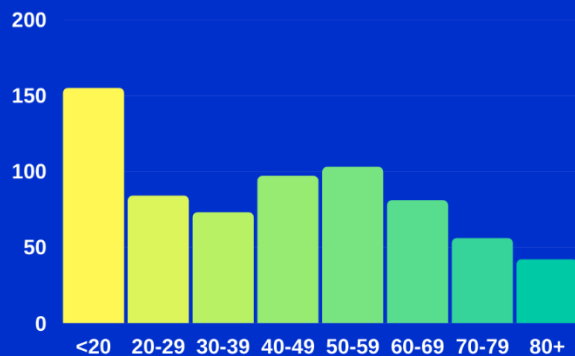

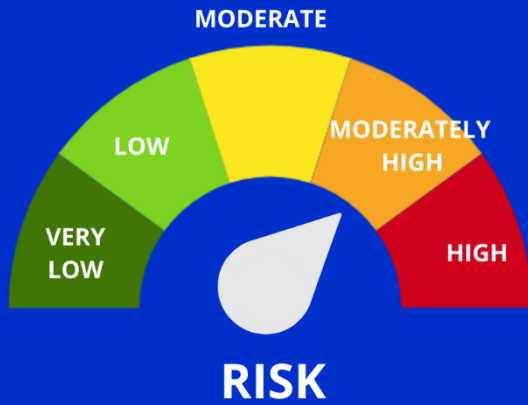

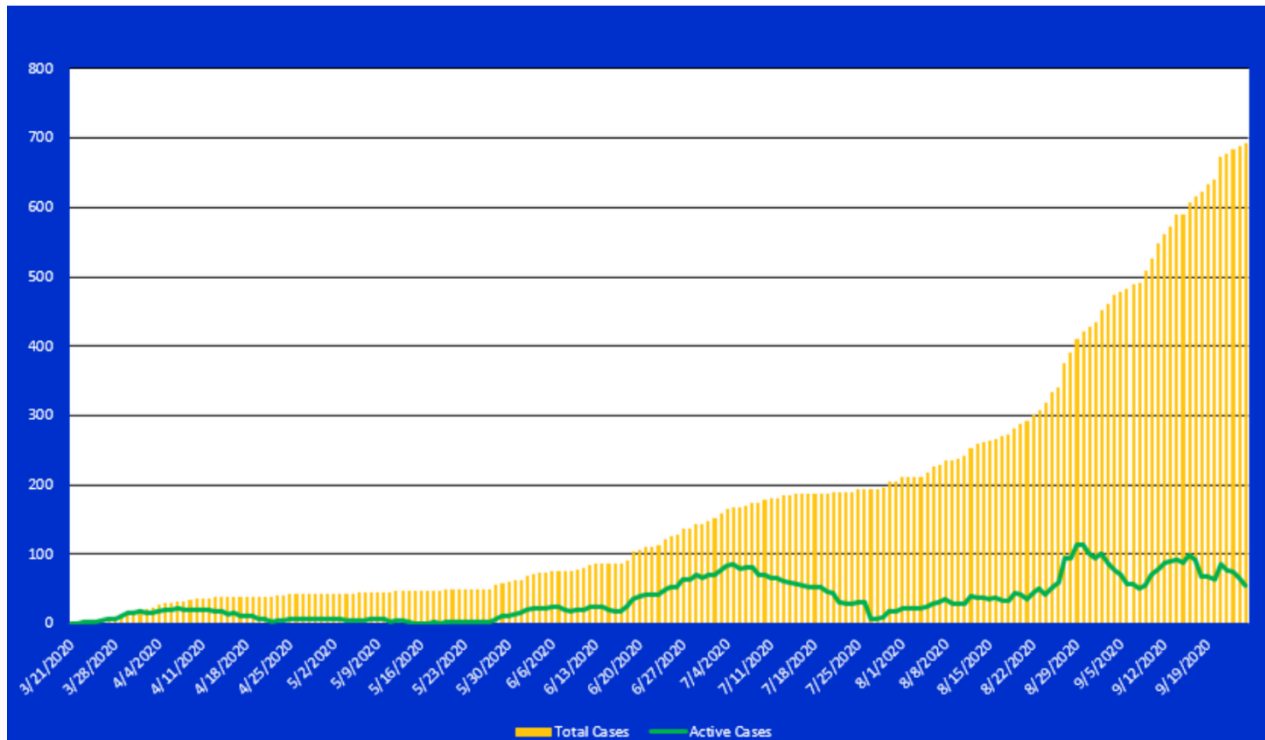

ACTION STEPS:
