

COVID-19 UPDATE 08/10/20 4:15 PM:

Nine new lab-confirmed cases in Perry County, MO since 08/7 update. Ten additional recoveries.

One of the probable cases of COVID-19 counted on the Friday update, now has a lab-confirmed test. Therefore, they have been moved from the probable case category to the lab-confirmed in the graphic below.

**They have not been duplicate counted in our graphic and were not counted in our daily new case count below.**

New cases 8/8: 6

New cases 8/9: 1

New cases 8/10: 2

Active Cases: 29

The CDC has three possible definitions for a probable case:

1. Meets clinical criteria and epidemiological evidence (no positive lab results)
2. Detection of specific antigen (positive antibodies) in a clinical specimen and meets clinical criteria or epidemiological evidence
3. Meets vital records criteria with no positive lab test
