If you were at Park-Et on Saturday, June 27th during the time given below, please monitor for symptoms until July 11th. It is encouraged for anyone who develops symptoms to reach out to their medical provider and seek testing and stay home until any testing results are received.

The affected business has been contacted and is following health department recommendations in response to this exposure.
